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Dear Brother Harris:


Your letter of December 1 is at hand and I reply. I assume that you had not yet received my second letter when you wrote this letter. Thank you for the information contained in your letter of Dec. 1. However, I shall await your reply to my second letter which information is of course very important to what we shall do about the Journal, etc.

Another matter has arisen on which I must ask your advice.

I informed the Eerdmans Publishing Company about this Journal of the WTS which we printed last year and plan to print again this year. Today Mr. Eerdmans wrote me stating that they would be happy to pay for a one page ad to carry the advertisement of the Wesleyan Bible Commentary in this years Journal. He suggested a figure of \$50.00 for such an ad, if we were interested in carrying it in the Journal. He did not make this figure final, but suggested it. As you know, many of the members of the WTS are also contributors to the WBC. It is my opinion that there would be space in the proposed Journal at the price quoted by the Pilgrim Press, should you think this proposition made by Eerdmans to have merit. Naturally the Editorial Committee of the WBC (Ralph Earle, Ralph Thompson, Lee Haines and C.W. Carter) would be happy to carry the ad for the WBC, and naturally the fee paid by Eerdmans for the ad would go toward the cost of printing the Journal. Please let me know your reactions to this proposal at once.
