Dear Dr. Harris:

At the executive committee of the National Holiness Association, which met in Dayton, Ohio, on Wednesday, May 21, following some discussion, it was decided to approve your constitution as follows:

Article II, Purposes.

Section 2, To accept leadership for the Doctrine Seminar program of the National Holiness Association.

Section 4. To publish a journal consisting of significant contributions to Wesleyan-Arminian scholarship.

Section 5. To serve as an editorial committee for the National Holiness Association.

Article V, Organization (approved as presented)

The executive committee, Dr. Harris, is most anxious to work with W.T.S. in any way to come to a satisfactory agreement as to our relationships one with the other, and are very happy to have W.T.S. working so closely with us. We would all be most disappointed if anything would cause the W.T.S. to withdraw from such close fellowship and relationship to the NHA. In our thinking it was also considered that we might combine the Holiness Preaching Seminar with the Doctrine Seminar. If W.T.S. chose to have two seminars, one in the field of doctrine and one in the field of holiness preaching, I think that would be satisfactory to us.

If you have any questions regarding any of our actions, kindly let me know so that we can clear them up to the best of our ability.

May God wonderfully bless you and direct you through the summer months. We appreciate the fine work you are doing both at Vennard College and with the Wesleyan Theological Society.
