Dear Dr. Carter:

I have a letter on my desk forwarded by Dr. Lamson and have not had opportunity to send you a note. He asked me to comment on two things in the letter, one was the possibility of a new book taking a new approach to the biblical ethic. I haven't seen the article that you refer to on "The Continuing Validity of Biblical Morality," and with no more information than I have I don't think I am in a very good position to react one way or the other.

Regarding the Wesleyan Theological Journal. I get confused as to how many times this is issued annually. I have been involved in attempting to distribute the Asbury Seminarian and I once proposed that the two journals get together. I see considerable barriers to this, however. We are going ahead on an increasing number of cooperative projects between ten denominations and one of the things that we certainly need is a theological journal. I would be interested in corresponding with you regarding the possibility of promoting it.

Frankly, I wish we had a journal which was split-level, one for the studious, intellectual pastor, and the other part of it for those who seem to require that everything be provided for them on the bottom shelf. In other words, incorporate some features that are in the Nazarene preachers' magazine, even though I don't like it. I prefer the scholarly myself, but we have a lot of preachers who simply ignore the scholarly magazine.

I now see a notice about the magazine which says it is \$1.00 a volume, and that you give 40% discount to anyone who buys in lots of ten or more. Perhaps the best thing for you to do would be to advertise in the Free Methodist. We do not normally carry any outside advertising, but I would permit this.
