Dear Br. Carter:

Thank you for your check for \$5.61 to cover the cost of the 15 copies of the 1970 WTJ which Edwards Brothers sent to you. You must have figured the cost late at night, or when you were not fully awake in the morning. According to my calculation—and you know that I (n) ever make mistakes!!—you should have sent \$5.83 instead of \$5.61 (15x31¢+25%=\$5.83). This, I believe, would fall under the category of Unwitting Sins, or doesn't your theology allow for such?

I sent Robert Mattke the 40 copies of the WTJ which you requested. They were as follows:

9 copies of Vl. I, 1966, WTJ @ 23¢ ea. = \$2.07 6 copies of Vol II, 1967, WTJ @ 35¢ ea. = 2.00 7 copies of Vol III, 1968 WTJ @ 37¢ ea. = 22.59 7 copies of Vol IV, 1969 WTJ @ 41¢ ea. = 2.87 11 copies of Vol. V, 1970 WTJ @ 31¢ ea. = 3.41

40 copies, total = \$12.94 Plus 25%= 3.26 Plus postage = .66 Grand total = \$16.86

After becoming more aware of some of the complications involved in changing the price of the Journal, I believe it would be better for us to leave it as it has been and change the price, if we do, at the beginning of another year. I have been selling the Journal for \$1.00 per single copy, 75¢ in lots of five to nine, and 60¢ per copy in lots of ten or more. Let's continue that policy for the present year and recommend whatever revision we may want to make for next year.

The Executive Committee as such is not scheduled to meet again this year, but has been requested to meet with a committee of the NHA in September, I believe, Dr. Emery will call it; he will know when and where.

I am sorry that Lloyd Knox has felt the omission of his paper from the <u>Journal</u> so keenly. I know you men acted upon your best judgment at the time in the matter. I hope and pray that permanent evil effects may not result from it.

We trust that your health has improved by now.
