Dear Friend and Brother in Christ:

It was decided at a recent Executive Committee meeting of the Wesleyan Theological Society that I should write you concerning your membership in the WTS.

The officers and other active members of the WTS are deeply concerned about those who have membership in the WTS and are anxious that none be lost to the the Society. There is always the possibility that letters from the Sec'y-Treas. have gone astray in the mails, or that there has been an unreported change of address.

While there is a ruling in the Society to the effect PROMOTIONAL SEC., Charles W. Carter that if a member of the WTS fails to pay his dues for two consecutive years and does not respond to the Sec'y-Treas.'s notices, he may be dropped from WTS membership, though he may be reinstated upon payment of dues. However, it is not the wish nor intention of the WTS to be either technical or legalistic in the application of the Society's rules. In fact we do not wish to lose any valuable members from fellowship. The WTS has been enjoying a very healthy and encouraging growth, having now reached a total of almost 300 members in six years.
