Houghton College—Buffalo CompusAt the recent meeting of the Program Committee of the WESLEY-AN THEOLOGICAL SOCIETY we did some long-range planning. We are thinking in terms of publishing a volume from the papers presented in our WTS meetings during the next two or three years.

> The INSIGHTS volumes, compiled by Dr. Geiger, we are told are going out of print. Therefore, we of W.T.S. want to put some worthy volumes on the market as their worthy successors.

We agreed at the Indianopolis meeting of the Program Committee that you should prepare a study which would analyze and answer the position of such men as Frederick Bruner and John Delbert R. Rose, Ph.D., Chairman R.W. Stott on the "Baptism with and Fullness of the Holy Spirit." This is a crucial issue among evangelicals in our time. Does the baptism with the Holy Spirit occur at the new birth, as a second crisis, or as a third work of grace?

The projected volume we have in mind would include appropriate O.T. and N.T. studies; several historical ones centering in our Wesleyan heritage; and an appropriate number on Wesleyanism and contemporary issues. For example, we are asking Charles W. Carter, Th.M., D.D., Charmon Kuhn to present a study at our 1973 annual meeting on "Theological Implications of Genetic some such theme as this: Engineering.
