You might ask Max what he thinks, and if he is favorable toward some days and/or weekends of ministry there, have him get in touch with me. Max heard Dr. Mitchell, and would know something of his potential in the areas named.

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I am assuming that you will not be having classes under the auspices of THE WESLEY CENTER FOR BIBLICAL STUDIES during the summer months. Am I correct in this? Otherwise I would have suggested having Dr. Mitchell at WCBS.

Say, we are looking forward to exploring the interest across USA in having another series of "holiness seminars" such as Dr. Kenneth Geiger conducted back in the early '60s which gave birth to the INSIGHTS volumes. Would you be interested in having such a "holiness seminar" at Wesley Center sometime during the fall of 1973 or the spring of 1974?

C We are just surveying the field to see what schools are interested, and then we'll sit down and select the centers where these "one-day seminars" will be held, and invite neighboring institutions and ministers, etc., to attend the seminar closest to them.
