There are 172 in all, which is 47 higher than in any previous year.

There appears to be a serious discrepancy between the number of members reported in 1974 as listed in the 1975 Journal, and the list of members which Prof. O. D. Lovell has. I do not know where this occurred, nor how, as I have been out of the country several years and not active again in the WTS until this last year. Therefore, it will be up to Dr. William Arnett, as the new chairman of the Membership Committee, and you to figure this out, if indeed it can be resolved.

Dr. William M. Arnett, Asbury Theological Seminary, now has the applications of all the new members gained in 1974-75, and should you wish to have access to these you may contact him.

I trust you have a good year in your new office as Secretary-Treasurer of the WTS. Actually Professor O.D. Lovell has been trying to do the work of that office plus that of the Promotional Secretary. The latter, according to the constitution, should be responsible for securing, in the main, new members for the society and handling the sale of the Journals, except those to be sent out to the paid members. When I was Promotional Secretary I performed those functions as per the Constitution. It is an impossible task when shifted to the Secy-Treas. However, you will handle this as you see best.
