I wrote Paul twice (in July, then August) to get information for my letter enclosing the WTS programs, but got no reply, so I finally called him around the middle of August. He said he had been on vacation. In the "Minutes" of the Executive Committee, April 24, 1984, I ran across this "minute":

The motion was made by R. Larry Shelton that printing deadlines be established with Old Paths Tract Society on an annual basis of April 15 and September 1, for the Spring and Fall numbers of the Journal. The motion was passed. The president will contact Old Paths to ascertain the deadlines they must establish for manuscripts to be first received, set, proofread and returned from the Editor, for printing and delivery of the Journal by April 15 and September 1 each year.

Old Paths does not operate on a fixed, rigid schedule to print our Journal, but they do excellent work at modest prices. Furthermore, aprinter cannot do the work until the copy is on hand, and that is where the main trouble has been. In the six years Alex Deasley served as Editor he never got a single issue out on time. Are we in for more of the same? As matters now stand, we are two issues behind schedule. From several sources in the past, I've understood that Paul B. has the reputation of getting his work done at much later than the lith hour, as well as well past the dead(OVER, please)
