Dear Dr. Bushong:

It was a pleasure to get to meet you at the Indianapolis convention of CHA. I enjoyed being a part of this year's meeting.

We should probably push our discussions forward on how to share office staff and mailing permits. The convention itself was too intense for you and me to give this quality attention. My final conversations with Dr. Arnett indicated that he is quite concerned to find relief in his assignment.

We could talk at more length by telephone. Either you could call me, or I can call you if you'll send along your phone number at World Gospel Missions. This might at least be advisable as a first step.

The best way to move for concrete leadership would be to schedule a meeting while you are at the CHA office in Wilmore. If you and your secretary could meet with Dr. Arnett and another officer of WTS, that would hold real promise for good understanding and mutual agreements. I could ask Dr. Melvin Dieter to represent WTS, or I could plan to attend the meeting myself. Such a meeting would fit my plans best after the academic year is completed here on May 20.

It might very well be that the next Secretary-Treasurer of WTS might not be located at Asbury Theological Seminary. So any arrangements that we could have in place, and tested for a year or more before such a change in personnel, would be very helpful. Routine matters could be handled through a central office with only certain items needing to go to the Secretary-Treasurer.
