Dear Howard,

It was good to see you this past weekend at our Lilly Endowment consultation.

At the meeting of the World Methodist Historical Society in Singapore the suggestion was made that the WMHS should collect a list of persons throughout the world who are working in various areas of Wesleyan studies. I was asked to head up this effort, and have begun to collect data. I'm writing to several Wesleyan studies organizations, asking for permission to integrate their membership or mailing lists into our total database.
