Since NHA is the parent organization of Wesleyan Theological Society I am, at the request of the Society's President Dr. William Arnett, submitting this report.

The Society met for its second annual conference on the campus of Asbury Theological Seminary November 4 and 5. While the attendance was not as high as it had been at the first conference of the society, there was a greater number of college and seminary students present and it was the involvement which helped make the conference a significant one.

At the time of the annual meeting 130 members were reported, but at the present time there are 159 accepted members and 4 applications for membership pending.

The treasurer was able to report that all of the society's financial obligations for its first year had been met and that a balance of \$182.46 was remaining in the treasury. In addition there was on hand a supply of about 350 copies of the society's first Journal, representing an additional revenue source of \$350.00. There are now 125 copies remaining.

The second Wesleyan Theological Journal has just been published and copies are now available to non-members at a price of \$1.00. Because of the fine acceptance accorded the first Journal, a press run of 1000 has been contracted. We hope to give this fine collection of holiness scholarship a broad circulation. This is another arm of NHA's enlarging ministry.

It seems evident that the enlarging membership and the increased sale of the Journal will enable WTS to operate without financial subsidy from the parent organization.
