**PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL REVISIONS** -- Pursuant to action taken at last November's meeting, a set of proposed changes in the WTS Bylaws has been drafted and is included with this mailing. Please read carefully the accompanying Memo from the Executive Committee which gives the rationale for the recommended changes.

**WTS JOURNAL UPDATE** -- All WTS members should have received by now Volume 24 (1989) of the Wesleyan Theological Journal. If you did not receive your copy, please let me know. I am happy to pass along word from Editor Paul Bassett that Vol. 25:1, containing the papers from the 1989 meeting, has been typeset, and Vol. 25:2 (the index volume) is in preparation.

**HONORARY MEMBERS** -- Our Bylaws provide that charter members, or anyone who retires after being a member for 20 years or more, continues as an Honorary Member, with full membership rights and privileges but without further payment of dues. In changing over to our present computer system, we failed to mention this and to provide a code for Honorary Members, which may have created some confusion. If you are an Honorary Member, be assured that you are exempt from further membership renewals.

**WTS INTERNATIONAL** -- WTS members will be interested to know that we now have members in Australia, Bahamas, Bolivia, Brazil, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, England, Germany, Honduras, Indonesia, Ivory Coast, Japan, Kenya, Korea, Macao, The Netherlands, Nigeria, Northern Ireland, Italy, Papua New Guinea, The Philippines, Portugal, Scotland, Sierra Leone, Singapore, South Africa, Spain, Swaziland, Trinidad, and the Virgin Islands, in addition to the U.S. and Canada. Recently a group of pastors in Seoul, Korea, joined. Also, the WTS Journal is received by a number of seminaries and colleges around the world.
