To illustrate: A recent \$10.00 check on a bank outside the US had a \$3.00 exchange fee that was eventually charged to our WTS checking account. Thank you for helping in this regard. Of necessity, we have the largest budget ever (\$20,700). Your prompt payment of dues will greatly assist us.

> 1. Annual Conference: A total of 126 members and friends registered for the 21st annual session at Olivet Nazarene College, Kankakee, IL, on Nov. 1 & 2, 1985. We are much indebted to Dr. George Lyons and others at Olivet in making arrangements for the Conference. Dr. H. Ray Dunning prepared and chaired an excellent program. Papers reflected thoughtful preparation. tendance averaged 85 to 145 for the various sessions. There were 55 Full members at the business session, and 102 attended the Banquet on Friday night. Constitutional changes went into effect, Dr. Frank G. Carver of Point Loma Nazarene College was elected First Vice-President and is now busy preparing for the 1986 program. Dr. Howard A. Snyder of Chicago was elected Second Vice-President and is being "seasoned" for the 1987 Fall program. As usual, the fellowship was great.
