Nazarene Theological Seminary is located in Southeast Kansas City, Missouri. Those arriving by automobile will enter Kansas City via Interstate 70 from the East and West and Interstate 35 from the North or South. Take the I-435 bypass around the South edge of the city to the State Route 71 Exit. Go North to Meyer Boulevard and West to the Seminary. **Note:** The Seminary is located in Missouri. There is also an I-435 bypass on the Kansas side. Do not confuse the two.

Those arriving by air will be met at the Kansas City International Airport. Arrangements must be made in advance with Rev. Marty Butler of the Nazarene Seminary. Call 816-333-6254 to leave your name, flight number, arrival time, address, and phone number. You may also write Rev. Butler at the Seminary address.

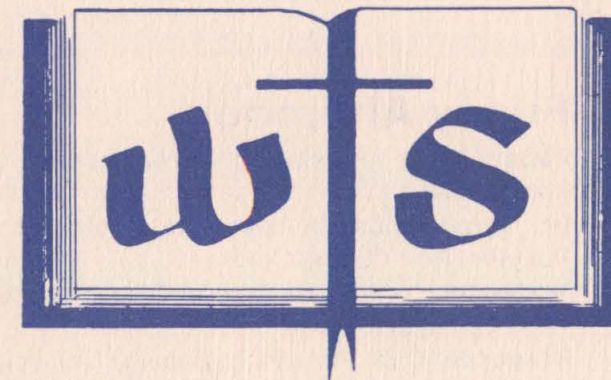
