TRANSPORTATION - Wilmore is sixteen miles south of Lexington, one mile from U.S. Route 68 and four miles west of U.S. Route 27. Wilmore may be reached in the following ways: by Southern Railway directly to Wilmore, by bus directly to Wilmore, via Greyhound and Phillips Coach Lines; by Chesapeake and Ohio Railway to Lexington and then by bus from Lexington to Wilmore. The Lexington airport, served by Eastern, Delta, and Piedmont airlines, is fifteen miles from Wilmore. SHUTTLE SERVICE will be provided by the Seminary from the Lexington airport and bus stations, and the Lexington and Wilmore depots, if desired.
