Olivet is approximately 80 miles south of Chicago (O'Hare Airport) in the village of Bourbonnais, north of Kankakee. This is 1½ miles southwest of Exit 315 on I-57. It is located at the junction of US 45-52 and Illinois 102.

Registration and Transportation

Registration and sessions will be in Kresge Auditorium of the new Larsen Fine Arts Center. There is ample visitor parking in front of the building.

For those arriving by plane there is limousine service available by advance reservation only. Contact: Checker Airport Service at (815) 932-3132. They pick up passengers every two hours from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. The round trip price is \$31 per person or \$26 in groups of 5 or more. Passengers are dropped off at the Regal 8 or the Holiday Inn. B & G Limousine provides a somewhat more expensive and more personalized limousine service ((815) 939-2776).

The Olivet College van will be available for those interested at a cost of \$100 for a round trip to O'Hare field. It seats 12 persons and the cost can be divided among the passengers. The van will provide shuttle service between motels and campus at a cost of \$1 per trip. Advance reservations must be made by writing well in advance to George Lyons, c/o Olivet.
