Papers of the Annual Meeting Wesleyan Theological Society Washington, D. C. November 1-2, 1996

The Fall 1997 issue of the Wesleyan Theological Journal will carry a selection of the edited papers presented at this annual meeting of WTS.

The Society's Editorial Committee will meet in December, 1996, to offer evaluation and suggestions to the Editor concerning the articles to be published. Consideration will be given only to those papers submitted directly to the Editor for consideration. The fact that a paper is presented at an annual WTS meeting does not automatically qualify it for consideration. A paper must be submitted consciously by the author for possible publication.

Submissions may be made to the Editor (1) at the annual meeting itself or (2) by mail any time before <u>December 1, 1996</u> (gives time for some editing by the author after presentation at the meeting). Materials are to be submitted to the Editor in both hardcopy and on computer disk (3 1/2 x 3 1/2 size disk, any wordprocessing program-Editor uses Mac with Microsoft Word, but can translate most others).

When submitting, an <u>author should include</u> professional title, place of service, mailing address, and e-mail address.

All authors submitting proposals should hear from the Editor no later than February 1, 1997, concerning whether or not the material submitted has or has not been accepted for publication.
