Isaiah 1:21-31

\*Psalmody Psalm 5

L: Give ear to my words, O Lord;

R: Consider my meditation.

L: Hearken to my cry for help, my King and my God,

R: for I make my prayer to you.

L: In the morning, Lord, you hear my voice;

R: early in the morning I make my appeal and watch for you.

L: For you are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness,

R: and evil cannot dwell with you.

L: Braggarts cannot stand in your sight;

R: You hate all those who work wickedness.

L: You destroy those who speak lies;

R: the bloodthirsty and deceitful, O Lord, you abhor.

L: But as for me, through the greatness of your mercy I will go into your house;

R: I will bow down toward your holy temple in awe of you.

L: Lead me, O Lord, in your righteousness, because of those who lie in wait for me,

R: make your way straight before me.

L: For there is no truth in their mouth;

R: there is destruction in their heart.

L: Their throat is an open grave,

R: they flatter with their tongue.

L: Declare them guilty, O God;

R: let them fall because of their schemes.

L: Because of their many transgressions cast them out,

R: for they have rebelled against you.

L: But all who take refuge in you will be glad,

R: they will sing out their joy for ever.

L: You will shelter them,

R: so that those who love your Name may exalt in you.

L: For you, O Lord, will bless the righteous,

R: you will defend them with your favor as with a shield.
