L: The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.

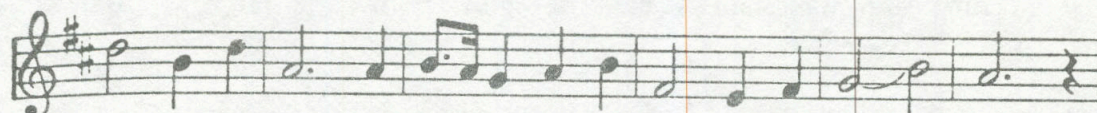

L: What shall we render to the Lord for our God's bounty to us?

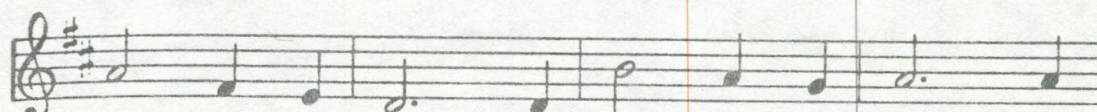
