choose for himself? 1. The popular song "What is to be will be" would indicate that we can't loose, that things just happen to us regardless of what we would like. Many people accept this view. One person recently told me that he thought things were pretty much like that.

2. The Old difference of importances between Presbyterians and Methodists was based on this question of whether or not we can choose for ourselves.

esbyterians, following the thinking of John Calvin, said that God has predestined everything that is to be and we have very little choice. Methodists Sught more as a man named Arminius. and said that God offers salvation and righteousness to every man but does not force it on him; that each is free to choose for himself his type of life.

elboint of compromise seems to be that God may have decided what is to be but that as far as you and I are con-
