Constitution

CO-ORDINATING COUNCIL FOR COMMUNITY LIFE OF THE DIVINITY SCHOOL

The Divinity School community consists of the student body, faculty, and the administrative officers. Each of these constituent groups has its distinctive functions and appropriate organizational structure. There are also actual and potential shared interests and activities of the corporate life which may be better fostered and guided by a Co-ordinating Council for Community Life. Such a Co-ordinating Council should represent the major groups and activities of the community; it should have limited co-ordinating, reviewing, and initiating powers appropriate to the common life; but it should not infringe upon the proper functions, responsibilities, and rights of the constituent groups nor confound valid distinctions of governmental prerogative belonging respectively to students, faculty, and administration.

I. MEMBERSHIP

The Co-ordinating Council for Community Life shall be composed of the following members:

- A. The president and vice-president of the Senior Class
 The president and vice-president of the Middler Class
 The president and vice-president of the Junior Class
 An elected representative of the M.R.E. students
 An elected representative of the Student Pastors
- B. A representative of the Th.M. students
 A representative of the Ph.D. students
 A representative of the Divinity Dames
 The president of the Duke Endowment Student Association
 - The student chairman for Missions
 The student chairman for Chapel Worship and Christian Life
 - The student chairmen of other standing committees as determined and appointed by the Co-ordinating Council (from within or without its number)
- C. Two faculty members elected annually by the Faculty
 The faculty chairman for Missions
 The faculty chairman for Chapel Worship and Christian
 - The faculty chairman for Community and Social Events
 The faculty chairman of Christian Responsibility and
 Cultural Trends (who shall be a member of the
 standing Committee on Social Responsibility and
 Special Ministries)
 - The Dean of Students
 The Dean of the Divinity School or his representative

II. OFFICERS

The officers of the Co-ordinating Council shall be a president, a vice-president, a secretary, and a treasurer. They shall be elected by the Council from the elected membership of the Council. Elected representatives are herein defined as Council members of Group A above. All members of the Council shall have a vote in these elections.

The Executive Committee shall be composed of the officers of the Co-ordinating Council, one of the two faculty members elected by the faculty, and the Dean or his representative.

III. COMMITTEES

The several committees which serve the Divinity School community (other than those proper to the administration or faculty) shall be responsible for the Co-ordinating Council for review, advice, and consent. The Council shall seek to encourage, emancipate, and co-ordinate the work of these committees. Other committees may be constituted by the Co-ordinating Council. The following committees are at present required for the common life of the Divinity School.

- A. Executive Committee of the Co-ordinating Council (see II). Its duties shall be to advise upon and review the work of the Council, to propose agenda for Council meetings, to take interim action for the Council on immediate problems, to propose policy or action within the competence of the Council, and where it is considered advisable, to recommend reconsideration of measures or suspension of action. The Executive Committee is an agent of the Co-ordinating Council and subject to its authority.
 - B. The Committee on Missions and Ecumenical Christianity*
 - C. The Committee on Chapel Worship and Christian Life*
 - D. The Committee on Social Life (including athletics)
 - E. The Committee on Social Responsibility and Special Ministries
 - F. The Committee on Intellectual and Academic Life
 - G. The Committee on Assemblies and Lectures (a representative of the Dean, Chairman, ex officio)
 - H. The Committee on Ministerial Ethics
 - I. The Committee on Publications
 - J. The Committee on Fine Arts

Other permanent or temporary committees may be established as the Council determines. As far as possible the com-

^{*}Where joint committees of students and faculty already exist, they shall be recognized as component committees of the Co-ordinating Council and their chairmen members of the same, ex officio.

mittees shall be free to develop their own system for electing their chairmen. If a committee has no procedure for electing its chairman, the Council shall elect him on recommendation of the Executive Committee. Committee chairmen are or shall be members of the Council. Membership of committees, not otherwise constituted, shall be determined by their chairmen and approved by the Council.

The Committee on Ministerial Ethics shall have as its chairman the president of the Co-ordinating Council and two members appointed by him with the approval of the Dean and the Council. On authorization of the Dean it shall be competent to review notices of unministerial conduct on the part of students and to report to the Dean. The Dean of Students shall serve in consultative capacity to the said committee.

The Committee on Intellectual and Academic Life shall have direct access to and consultative relation with both the chairman of the faculty committee on curriculum and the Dean. Its chairman shall be the president of the Co-ordinating Council.

The Committee on Publications shall have responsibility for all student publications or student editorial activity. Its chairman shall be the vice-president of the Co-ordinating Council, ex officio. Its membership shall comprise the editorial staff of student publications or publications in which students share responsibility with the Dean's office, as in the case of the Directory. It shall have a faculty consultant, as representative of the Dean, from among faculty elected annually to the Co-ordinating Council.

IV. OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COUNCIL

It is the responsibility of the Co-ordinating Council to promote the general welfare of the Divinity School community in cooperation with the Dean and faculty. It shall consider issues relating to that welfare, convene open community meetings at least once each semester to report to and discuss with the community the activities of the Council, and convene special meetings of the community when they are deemed necessary.

It shall hold monthly meetings and conduct business only when a quorum (a simple majority) is present.

It shall determine the amount of the student activity fee and approve the budget. It shall require and receive reports from agencies and committees receiving funds from the Council treasury; and it shall see that the treasurer's books are audited annually.

It shall approve appointments of committees and chairmen, determine parliamentary procedure, remove from office those officers who fail to carry out their duties, and provide through its Executive Committee a forum for grievances. It shall review such grievances and/or refer the same to the proper committee if such reference is deemed advisable.

The groups which elect representatives to the Council shall have the right of initiation and recall and shall receive periodic reports.

The vice-president of the Council shall have the responsibility for student elections. He shall be chairman ex officio of

the Committee on Publications.

The president shall vote only in case of a tie vote. He shall be chairman ex officio of the Committee on Ministerial Ethics and the Committee on Intellectual and Academic Life.

V. APPROVAL OF THE DEAN

As the University official charged with the responsibility for the activities and well-being of the Divinity School, the Dean shall reserve power to review all actions of the Co-ordinating Council with the right to re-submit decisions for reconsideration or to veto decisions which, in his judgment, impair the welfare of the school, impinge upon faculty and/or administrative prerogative or are otherwise judged deleterious to the common life of the Divinity School.

VI. ELECTIONS

In so far as possible provision shall be made for the election and/or designation of Council members not later than three weeks prior to the examination period of the spring semester in order to provide for an organizational meeting of the new

Council and election of officers for the ensuing year.

The outgoing president shall convene the organizational meeting and preside over the election of the executive committee: president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer, in that order. Election shall be by successive secret ballot without nomination. A two-thirds majority shall be enough to secure election providing that, in the election of the executive committee, three-fourths of the membership must be present and voting.

VII. ENABLING PROVISION

This instrument of organization shall become operative when it shall have been approved: (1) by a two-thirds vote of a called meeting of the student body (including B.D., M.R.E., and Th.M. candidates), a simple majority being present and voting, and (2) by a two-thirds majority of the full-tme faculty, two-thirds being present and voting, and (3) by the approval of the Dean. It shall not be established without the approval of

any one of these parties.

This instrument of organization is offered by the constituted committee on reorganization of community life in full understanding that the said instrument is experimental in nature and admits of review, amendment, revision (or dissolution) as larger experience suggests or unforeseen circumstances direct. Initiative in these matters may be undertaken by the Co-ordinating Council itself or by any one of the approving parties, noted in paragraph one of the Enabling Provision above. The structure of the Co-ordinating Council may be amended, revised, or dissolved, in the same manner in which it was originally established.

DIVINITY DAMES

The Divinity Dames is an organization of wives and women students in the Divinity School of Duke University which offers opportunities for fellowship, spiritual growth and instruction in various aspects of parish life and in theological and Biblical subjects. The dean and faculty are concerned to assist the members of the organization in understanding church-related vocations and their appropriate participation in them.
