

TO THE DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT AND MEMBERS OF THE SECOND QUARTERLY
CONFERENCE, TRINITY CHURCH, APRIL 7, 1943:

The Woman's Society of Christian Service of Duke Memorial Church had an enrollment of 193 members on Jan. 1, 1943. During the 1st Quarter 12 new members have been enrolled; 2 have dropped out,-- leaving a total membership at end of quarter of 203.

The Work of the Christian Social Relations and Local Church Activities Committee has been outstanding. In addition to cooperating with other agencies in helping the three Nursery schools in Durham and the County Home, the Committee reports \$267.75 spent on relief. The Society voted to accept the suggestion of Mrs. Gates, Chairman of Supplies, that layettes be made for the E. Laurinburg Community Center. Tuesday April 13 has been set as the date when the clothes will be made.

The Society cooperated with Dr. Glenn in sponsoring the study course on Latin America. Two evenings were devoted to the study and fellowship dinners in which all the membership shared. Prominent speakers, Dr. Alan Manchester, Mrs. F. S. Love, Dr. Clyde Erwin, and Mrs. James Cannon made interesting and informative talks on these countries and the work which our denomination is doing there.
