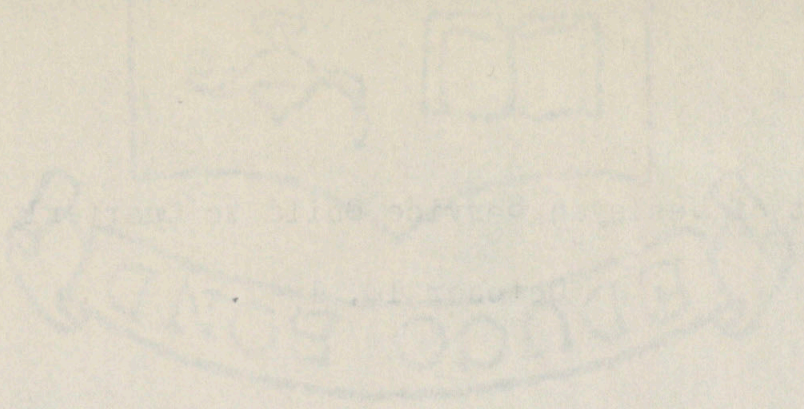
\$34.75 in pledges was turned in to the treasurer of the Woman's Society of Christian Service.

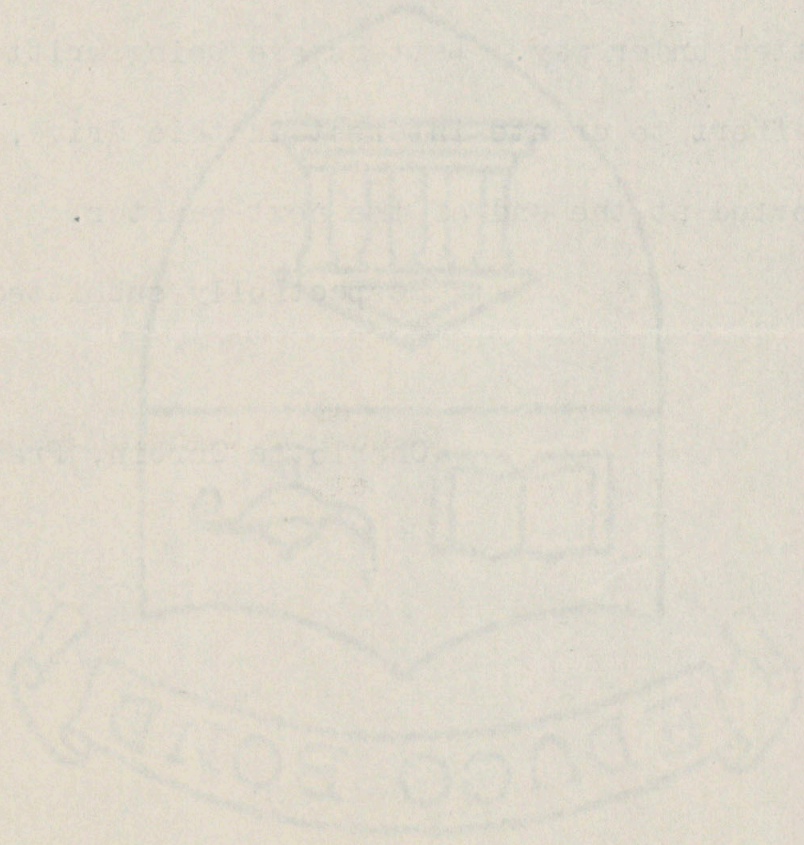

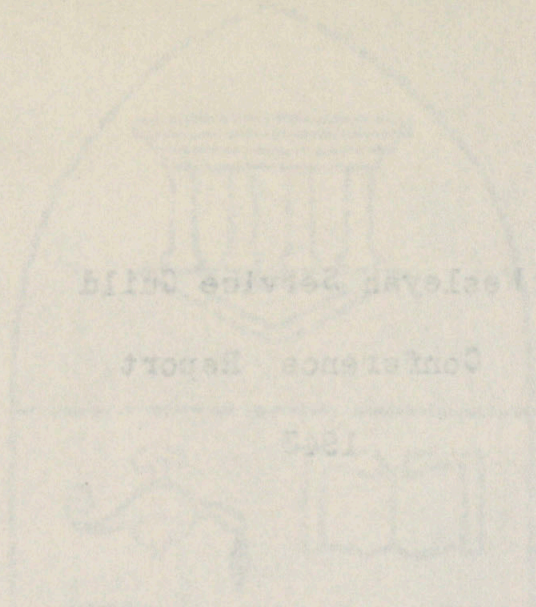
