Service Activities The Society formed a new night circle composed of young war mothers thereby adding 22 new members to its roll. Paid expenses of two Negro delegates to the Pastor's School at Winston-Salem, clothed an orphan at the Methodist Orphanage at Raleigh and contributed generously to the Nursery Schools. Served three church dinners in connection with the Crusade for Christ, Methodist Young^h Fellowship, and the Church's Visitation Campaign in addition to luncheons for study courses. Representatives from the Society attended Interdenominational Bible Groups, Council of Social Agencies and participated in the observance of Universal World Day of Prayer and the Jurisdictional Study Course at Calvary Methodist Church. Sent \$150 worth of clothing to our missionaries in Africa serving under Bishop Garber.
