

Mr. Mims united with Duke Memorial Methodist Church at the morning service, May 20, being received by transfer from the Brandon Memorial Methodist Church, Tuscaloosa, Alabama.


After the Quarterly Conference had been called to order by the pastor, Mr. Mims was introduced and after making a statement about his call to the ministry, he asked the Quarterly Conference to recommend him for local preacher's license.

The Quarterly Conference voted unanimously to recommend Mr. Mims to the Ad Interim Committee, Durham District Conference, for local preacher's license. There being no further business to come before the Quarterly Conference, it was adjourned.
