the paying of the expenses of two Negro delegates to Pastor's School at Winston-Salem and the clothing of an orphan at the Methodist Orphanage in Raleigh. We sent Christmas boxes (totalling \$65 in value) overseas to our war-torn areas. Cooperated with Dr. Glenn in the Church's Visitation Campaign, serving a dinner for these workers, a luncheon for the Durham District Set Up Meeting in addition to sponsoring luncheons in connection with study courses and monthly meetings of the Society. Representatives from the Society attended Council of Social Agencies and Interdenominational Bible Groups. The Society together with the Sister Methodist Societies of the city entertained the State Conference of the Woman's Society of Christian Service March 26, 27, 28, 1946 and housed and fed several hundred visiting delegates. All in all, our Society has experienced a good year and looks forward to even more fruitful results in the days and years to come.
