


First Quarterly Conference

January 8, 1946

As the Woman's Society of Christian Service runs with the calendar year and not concurrently with the conference year this report will include the fourth quarter work of the society covering the months October, November and December of 1945.


During the last quarter 12 new members were added to the roll making the total membership 238. Money sent to the conference Treasurer during this time totalled \$555.05. Of this amount \$100.65 was contributed by the Wesleyan Guild. Beginning October 25th three days of meditation, prayer and a Bible Study conducted by Dr. Franklin Young of Duke University were held in observance of the Annual Week of Prayer and the self denial offering during that time totalled \$126.35.

3 New Members



Members of the Society contributed for relief \$554.69 through the Christian Social Relations Committee, sent \$50.00 to Payne College, \$5.00 to Eastern Carolina Teacher's College, + twelve Christmas overseas boxes (totalling \$65 in value) to our war torn areas. For four consecutive Tuesday mornings in November some 28 members of our Society attended and received credit for the work completed in the Jurisdictional Study Course "The Cross over Africa", taught so ably by Mrs. A. N. Borland at Trinity Church. In addition to this 22 of our women attended the Education Seminar held in Chapel Hill.

During the quarter members of the Society cooperated with Dr. Glenn in the Church's Visitation Campaign and in serving a dinner for these workers and also a luncheon for the Durham District Set-Up Meeting.
