

# Pastor's Report to the Quarterly Conference

Duke Memorial Charge R. E. Brown Pastor Dec. 9, 1947

Discipline ¶ 223 (20) states as one of the duties of the Pastor "To make a written report to each Quarterly Conference" on the General State of the Church in his Charge.
