

# Pastor's Report to the Quarterly Conference

Duke Memorial Charge Robert E. Brown Pastor October 5, 1948

Discipline ¶ 223 (20) states as one of the duties of the Pastor "To make a written report to each Quarterly Conference" on the General State of the Church in his Charge. This should include names of all whose Membership Relation has changed, Pastoral Instruction and Labors, Plans for Future Work and the Work of the Organizations.
