The Committee for the selection of a Church Hostess reported that it employed Mrs. Mary Land to begin work November 15.

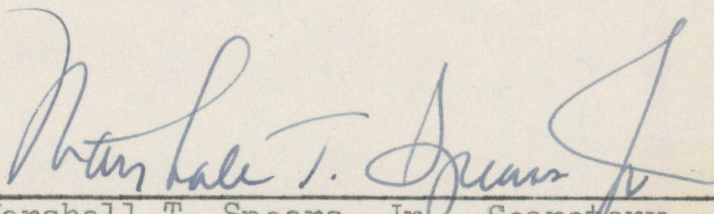
