

The Official Board of Stewards held its regular meeting in the church parlor, Tuesday, Sept. 2, 1957, with Chairman Charles Chewning, presiding. The opening prayer was offered by the Rev. Mr. Queen after which the August minutes were read and approved.

Dr. Sam Holton reporting for the Commission on Education explained plans for the new Sunday School year which included the recruiting of teachers and the grater planning in teaching activities.

Mr. Shoaf announced that Christian Education Week would be from Sept. 29-Oct. 5 and Rally Day plans were given, and further activities of that week were explained. Mr. Shoaf also announced that the Daily Vacation Bible School held in August was one of the best in years.

Mr. C. J. Jones, treasurer, gave his report and a copy is attached to these minutes.

Dr. Glassom, Chairman of Stewardship and Finance, announced that we still need about \$6000 in additional pledges to meet the expected expenditures for the year.

Mr. Queen announced that the first quarterly conference will be held concurrently with the regular December meeting of the Stewards.

The question of the format for the Sunday Church Bulletin was referred to the "orship Committee.

The suggestion of creating a church library was discussed. A motion by Mr. Whitford, seconded by Mr. Dunham, was made to the effect that a steering committee be appointed by Mr. Chewning to study the matter further. This committee is to be composed of Mrs. Borland, Mr. Barton, Dr. Holton, Dr. Glasson, and Mr. Queen.

There being no further business presented the meeting was adjourned by prayer by Mr. Shoaf.
