

Minutes of Church Conference  
Duke Memorial Methodist Church, Durham, N. C.

Sunday - September 14, 1958

The Church Conference of Duke Memorial Methodist Church was called to order by the pastor, Reverend Robert W. Bradshaw, on Sunday, September 14, 1958, following the Morning Worship. Mrs. Arthur Kale was named Secretary. Mr. Bradshaw stated that the purpose of the Conference was to consider the sale of a part of the church lawn on the Duke Street side to the City of Durham, a transaction already approved by the Quarterly Conference and now requiring action by the Church Conference. Mr. Charles W. Chewning, Chairman of the Official Board, was introduced, and he presented Judge Marshall T. Spears for the purpose of presenting, in behalf of the Trustees, a resolution relating to the proposed sale.

Judge Spears read the attached resolution stating that the members of the Church Conference were now asked to take such action as seemed wise. (See Resolution). Dr. Charles E. Jordan moved that the resolution be adopted and this motion was seconded by Mr. E. C. Brooks, Jr. Following discussion the question was called and the vote taken. The motion was passed.

The Conference was adjourned.
