Mr. Coman made the motion, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that a committee be appointed to look into paving the parking lot. The motion carried. Mr. Coman and Mr. Dillard Teer were appointed by the Chairman, with a third member to be selected by the committee.

Mr. Jordan made the motion, seconded by Mr. Teer, that a letter of thanks be written Mr. Bascom ^{Baynes} ~~Bayels~~, Pres. of Home Security Life Insurance for extending the use of the parking lot behind the office building to Duke Memorial on Sundays.

The meeting was closed with prayer by Mr. Shoaf.
