The Official Board of Duke Memorial Church held its regular meeting on Tuesday evening, April 5, in the Church Parlor, with Mr. Chewning presiding. Following prayer by the pastor, the minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Dr. Glasson, in a report for the Commission on Stewardship and Finance and for the Treasurer, in the absence of Mr. Jones, pointed out that current operating expenses had been paid but that Conference obligations were still outstanding.

The Commission met on March 23, Dr. Glasson said, and heard a report on the district-wide Conference on the Every Member Canvass, which was a re-evaluation of the church program with helpful suggestions for its operation. Ideas presented may be considered in planning for the future.

Dr. Glasson also stated that work on the Church budget was under way and that the Commission, meeting as a whole, would hear requests at its regular session on the fourth Wednesday in April. Mr. Chewning asked that a representative from each group desiring financial assistance be present at that time with definite information as to its needs.

Mr. Bradshaw reported that the fourth Quarterly Conference would be in connection with the June meeting of the Board. He stressed the need for action by all church members if the financial obligations for the year are to be met.

During the year 70 new members have been taken into the Church, according to Mr. Bradshaw, and approximately 25 were in the Easter membership class.

Mr. Angier said that Dillard Teer had been responsible for having the Church walks and parking area cleared during a recent snow. The secretary was instructed to write a letter of appreciation to Mr. Teer.

The meeting was dismissed with prayer by Mr. Shoaf.
