

April 3, 1962

The Official Board of Duke Memorial Church met on April 3, 1962, at 7:45 p.m. in the Church Parlor with Mr. Goad presiding. General Holsinger gave the opening prayer, and the secretary read the minutes of the previous meeting which were approved as read.

Mr. T. S. White presented the budget for the year 1962-63, with estimated expenditures and receipts totalling \$97,988.00, \$5,562 more than those for the current year. His motion for its adoption was seconded and unanimously approved. A copy of the budget is attached.

Brief reports were made for the Commissions as follows: Education by Mr. Whitford, who stated that a vacation training institute had been held with ten members present; Membership and Evangelism by Mr. Fowler, who gave special recognition to the excellent work of General Holsinger; Missions by Mrs. Borland, who made a statement regarding the needs for missionary workers.

Mr. Bradshaw spoke briefly on the Building Fund Crusade and the need for the members of the church to "catch the vision" so all can move into the weeks ahead with a feeling of concern and victory.

Mr. Goad called attention to the responsibility of the Board members, as lay leaders, in being well informed on the needs of the church and keeping others informed.

The meeting was dismissed with prayer by Mr. Bishop.
