The Official Board of Duke Memorial Methodist Church held its regular meeting on Tuesday, February 8, at 7:45 p.m. in the Bradshaw Room. Dr. John Glasson, the chairman, presided.

Following prayer by Mr. Bishop, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved as distributed and reports of the commissions and committees were called for but none were made.

In the absence of Mr. Reade, the treasurer's report for seven months ending January 31 was made by Mr. McLean, as follows: total receipts, \$63,248.33; total disbursements, \$62,446.43; cash balance \$5,663.86. Mr. Jones' report on the Building Fund gave the good news that the entire indebtedness on the educational building had been retired with a cash balance on hand, as of February 2, of \$134.43 and pledges receivable of \$36,956.00.

Mr. Cliff presented to the church from the Methodist Men the 1966 Church Directories, which were distributed among the stewards, together with an insert and questionnaire, for circulation among the church membership. As outlined by Mr. Bishop, it was felt this was an excellent way to show interest and concern in the membership, as well as to gather, through the questionnaire, basic information for the use of the church.

Mr. Petteway thanked the Methodist Men for the directories and the Board for its assistance in the distribution. He also expressed gratification for the recognition given Duke Memorial Church at the Durham District Conference the previous week when it had been on the honor roll of churches in the number of members received and in benevolent giving during the first six molents of the Conference year.

Mr. Petteway said the suggestion had been made that a 9:00 o'clock service of worship be held on Sunday mornings, and he would be glad to hold it provided there were enough people interested. He also reminded the Board that the educational building would be dedicated the Sunday following Easter.

The meeting was adjourned with prayer by the Pastor.
