

ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 9, 1969

The Administrative Board of Duke Memorial United Methodist Church met in the Bradshaw Room on Tuesday, September 9, 1969, at 7:45 p.m. Mr. Marshall Spears, Jr., chairman, presided.

Reverend Morris L. Husted gave the invocation.

The minutes of the July meeting were approved. There was no meeting of the Board in August.

The Church Treasurer, Mr. Bailey Reade, gave the following report on Receipts and Disbursements for two months ending August 31, 1969: total receipts \$25,470.59 total disbursements \$27,009.84; excess expenses (\$1,539.25); cash forwarded 6/30/69 \$5,964.86; total cash on hand \$4,425.61. Total Conference payments for the year are \$43,300.00. We have on hand now \$10,950.00 for Conference payments which covers June, July and August of this year. Total to date paid on Building Fund amounts to \$281,992.79 (i.e. phase 1).

Mr. Spears, Mr. Few and Reverend Petteway reminded the Board members of their needed cooperation in the success of the Sanctuary Renovation-Organ Crusade.

Reverend Petteway announced that Dr. A. Purnell Bailey could come to Duke Memorial for special services October 26 through 29. Since the Board had voted in the affirmative for Reverend W. B. Petteway to extend the invitation to Dr. Bailey in July, it was not necessary for another motion to be made; however, Mr. Norwood Carroll made a motion that the former motion be reaffirmed. This was carried in the affirmative.

Mr. Whitford announced that Promotion Day was held September 7th and Bibles were presented to the rising third graders.

Miss Kay Parks, Director of Christian Education, reported that 150 participated in Vacation Bible School August 18 through 22nd. She attended Lab. School at Junaluska August 10 through 15 and a meeting on Holistic Ministries August 15 through 17th. There will be a training session for church leaders at Trinity Church on September 22, 7:00- 9:00 p.m. and members of The Council on Ministries are urged to attend. The adult training conference will be held at Camp Chestnut Ridge October 17 - 18 and November 14-15.
