Report to the Board of Christian Education on the Vacation School, 1932.

The attendance at the school was far in excess of what we had expected and planned for, the total enrollment being approximately 150. Two departments were formed, Junior and Primary. The total enrollment in the Junior Department was 59 and the average attendance was 45. The average attendance of the Primary Department was approximately 65. In the Junior Department there were 21 children from Memorial Church, 25 from Temple Baptist, 6 from Main Street Christian, and 1 each from the Missionary Alliance, Trinity Avenue Presbyterian, Watts Street Baptist, and First Presbyterian churches, with 3 whose church affiliation is unknown.

Materials prepared and recommended by the Children's Division of the Board of Christian Education were used. The units were: for the Juniors, "How Nations Share", and for the Primaries, "Children of One Father".

A total of \$21.50 was received from various sources, mostly from contributions sent by parents of the children. The total expense of the school was \$18.50, the balance going into the Sunday School Treasury.

The following helpers volunteered and gave splendid assistance, without which the school could hot have been held: Kathleen Long, Helen Card, Elizabeth Duke, Elizabeth Hooper, Inez Abernethy, Estelle Knight, Bess McGlothlin, Madeline McGlothlin, Tempe Newson, Bess Breedlove, Dorothy Cole, Mrs. F. H. Greene, Superintendent of the Primary Department, had charge of the Primary group.
