The meeting was called to order and the minutes read and approved.

It was reported that Mrs. McAllister had taken the girls' class and that Mr. Tuttle had taken the boys' class in the Senior Department.

The Pastor and Superintendent reported that the Standard Training School had been postponed until later on in the winter, probably in January or February.

The Superintendent requested that a list of all teachers in all departments be in by the next meeting.

Mr. Proctor reported that the Record System had been put in use, but that there was still some misunderstanding about it, so he asked for some time at the Workers' Council to tell about it. He also reported that the Bulletin Board had been put up and used for the first time the preceding Sunday.

Mrs. Green asked for a screen to put up between classes in her Assembly room. A committee of Mrs. Green, Mr. Foster, and Mr. Angier was appointed to get the screen, the cost not to exceed \$8.00.

The question of discipline in the school was brought up, but no definite conclusions were reached. The Superintendent reported that he thought the general morale of the school was greatly improved, expressing the hope that it would continue to do so.

The meeting then adjourned for the Workers' Council supper.
