

February 28, 1933.

The meeting was called to order by Prof. Holton, and the minutes were read and approved.

It was reported that Mr. Myers would take up the Mission Study book in his class and that the other adult classes would be privileged to come in with them if they so desired.

Dr. Stanbury brought up the question of Mrs. Peppler's class in the Young People's Department, and the whereabouts of the girls who were members before its disbanding. It was decided that about the only thing that we could do would be to send cards to them inviting them to come to one of the other classes in the department; and this was to be done by the departmental secretary.

The problem of whether or not the first year class of boys in the Intermediate Department should be divided or not, was brought up and discussed. It was decided to leave the matter up to the counselor and class teacher, but the general opinion was that it would be better not to divide them at present, because of the feeling of class loyalty among the group.

A community survey, being sponsored jointly by the Temple Baptist, Christian, Lutheran, and our own church, was laid before the Board by the pastor. The survey was to be conducted the following Sunday afternoon, and the workers were to meet at the Lutheran Church at 2 o'clock. Our Board agreed to lend its support and co-operation, and to call for workers from the Sunday School to help in the canvass.
