

February 26, 1958

The Commission on Education met February 26, 1958 directly after the Workers Conference.

Mr. Umstead moved that the Boy Scout charter be renewed. Approved.

Mr. Mansfield moved, Mr. Umstead seconded, that the MYF retreat planned for April 25 be approved. Approved.

Mr. Shoaf reported eleven regular members are attending the Leadership Training Class with 2 others attending irregularly. Only one of these is now a regular teacher at Duke Memorial.

Thirty-two (32) persons from Duke Memorial were enrolled in the Leadership School held at Asbury.

Mr. Shoaf led discussion of evaluation program. Committee appointed to plan evaluation program is composed of Mr. Allen, Mr. Shoaf, Miss Johnson, Miss Glass.

Mr. Shoaf reported that three Duke students are now working in the Junior and Intermediate Departments.

Summer activities, including camps, assemblies, leadership schools, junior day camps, vacation church school, were discussed. No action taken.

Financing family nights was discussed. It was the opinion of the group that MYF members whose families do not attend be asked to bring some food or contribute towards supper.

Time for Sunday School tabled until March meeting.

Meeting closed with prayer by Mr. Shoaf.
