

May 19, 1958

The Commission on Education met May 19, 1958 with the following members present: Mrs. Aydlett, Mrs. Bookout, Mr. Chewning, Mrs. Coble, Miss Glass, Mr. Holton, Miss Johnson, Mr. Shoaf, Mr. Whitford, and Mrs. Eugene Phillips, visitor.

Mr. Whitford moved, Miss Glass seconded that the Scout Council Constitution be adopted. Approved.

Miss Elizabeth Johnson, Mr. Whitford, and Mr. Shoaf were appointed by the Chairman to serve on budget committee for church school.

Mrs. Eugene Phillips was introduced to the group by Mr. Shoaf.

She explained why the primary^{department} (1st and 2nd grades) needs more space. After discussion and viewing several departments in the church school, Miss Johnson moved, Mr. Whitford seconded that the Scout room be used temporarily (on condition that this be approved by the Scout Council) for the primary department. Approved.

Mrs. Bookout moved, Mr. Whitford seconded, that the Chairman appoint a committee to prepare plans for renovation of the church school rooms. Approved. Chairman stated that Mrs. Bookout and Mr. Shoaf should serve as two of the members of this committee.

Mrs. Bookout moved, Mr. Whitford seconded that the Commission approve the re-employment of the present week~~day~~ school teachers and that the Commission authorize the week-day school committee to draw up a formal contract with these teachers. Approved.

Commission approved the plans of the Senior MYF for Family Night, June 22 and decided to delay action on later family night programs.

Commission decided to delay the beginning of the evaluation program until new members of Commission are elected.

The superintendents of departments will meet May 25 to discuss plans for Vacation Church School to be held July 14- 25, 1958.
