

September 24, 1958

The Commission on Education met September 24, 1958. Chairman Sam Holton presided.

The Committee (composed of Mr. Whitford, Mr. Coman, Mrs. Kale, Mrs. Dunham, Mrs. Chewning) for discussing space in the church is to report at next evaluation session.

Rally Day will be a part of church service, along with presentation of Bibles to Primary students and dedication of church school workers and officers.

Mr. Whitford moved, Allan seconded, that this commission sponsor a Workers' Conference October 1 and that a dinner for workers be given. Approved.

Mrs. Booukout reported on needed supplies for Children's Division. Mr. Perian moved that these supplies be approved.

Mr. Shoaf gave a report on staff members of the church school. Mr. Shoaf moved, Mr. Few seconded, that these teachers be approved.

It was the opinion of the Commission that the official hours of Sunday School should be 9:30 to 10:40. Letters are to be sent to all students. Announcements will be made to all adult classes by the Adult Superintendent.

Mr. Shoaf reported that the first planning session for the new young adult class will be Sunday, October 5. Mrs. Crenshaw has the telephone detail with about 20 couples on the list.

Tom Coble will inquire about baby cribs in adult classes. Announcements of this need will be in bulletin.

Division superintendents and superintendent will meet to talk about S. S. budget, etc.

Mr. Few moved, Mr. Coble seconded, that a committee be appointed to study the problem of attendants for nurse during church hour and that this committee meet with members of the Official Board and make definite recommendations with power to act on this matter. Approved.

Mr. Few moved, Mrs. Dunham seconded that the meeting date of this Commission be changed to the third Monday of the month. Approved.
