

October 20, 1958

The Commission on Education met October 20, 1958 with Chairman Sam Holton, presiding. Mr. Whitford opened the meeting with prayer.

Chr. Holton recognized Judy Cooke, President of the Senior MYF, who told the Commission of the MYF plans for a day of fellowship with the Kinston, N. C. MYF, Saturday, October 25, 1958. She stated that Duke Memorial MYF needs \$40.00 to help cover expenses for this event. Mr. Whitford moved, Mr. Coble seconded, that the Commission allocate funds for this project. Approved.

Mr. Whitford moved, Mrs. Bookhout seconded, that the Commission approve the nomination of Mr. A. B. Windham as secretary of record system. Approved.

Mr. Whitford moved, Mr. Coble seconded, that a workers' conference be held Wednesday, November 12 for all departments. Superintendents, teachers, presidents and secretaries of classes, commission members and other interested persons will meet for supper, after which they will meet in their respective classes or departments to observe and to be instructed by specialists in each field of work. Approved.

Mr. Whitford moved, Mrs. Kale seconded that this supper be a dutch affair. Approved.

Tom Coble reported that the college class is growing and needs more space. Mr. Shoaf is teaching young married couples class at present. Their next series of lessons will be on the parent education theme. Space problems of these and other classes were discussed at length.

The Commission visited the classrooms of the Youth Division. Mr. Chewning moved, Mr. Coble seconded, that the space committee diagram space needs for the church school. This committee will take particular note of the needs in Senior Department and recommend to commission special needs, decorations, and equipment. Approved.

Mr. Whitford will discuss with Mr. Stephens, teacher of 4th grade, equipment needed for this class.

Mr. Chewning moved, Mrs. Kale seconded, that a blackboard for 5th grade be approved. Approved.

Commission decided to postpone action on funds for classes and departments until Mrs. Bookhout talks over this problem with teachers in the Children's Division.

Mr. Chewning moved, Mrs. Dunham seconded, that Chr. Holton, Rev. Bradshaw, Mr. Shoaf, and Mr. Whitford work on the budget for church school.

Mr. Shoaf moved, Mr. Coble seconded that a chancel play be given December 21 and that the social committee be responsible for refreshments at open house afterwards.

Rev. Bradshaw dismissed the meeting with prayer.
