

JULY 20, 1959

The Commission on Education met on July 20, 1959 with Chairman John Perian presiding. The chairman invited Mr. Bradshaw to open the meeting with prayer.

Chairman Perian stated that the first item of business was the election of a vice-chairman and a secretary. Mr. Whitford nominated Mr. Tom McCauley as vice-chairman; Mrs. Hargitt seconded the motion. Mrs. Tom Coble nominated Mrs. Hargitt as secretary. The elections were carried.

Mr. Shoaf stated that Mrs. Katherine Reams has been employed in the 2-year-old nursery during the church hour for \$3.50 per Sunday.

Mr. Whitford reported that the S.S. attendance has decreased due to summer vacations; the method of ordering literature has improved. Mr. Whitford wants to meet with the secretaries of all classes to work out plans for rolls.

Mr. Shoaf reported an attendance of 116 children registered on this first day of Vacation Church School, with 24 staff members present.

For the day school Mrs. Duncan Herron (Anderson St.) has been appointed to work <sup>in</sup> the nursery group, Mr. Shoaf said, as a replacement for Mrs. J.O. Cox. The roll is full.

The Junior day camp which will start August 24 is staffed. It will be held at Camp Chestnut Ridge jointly with Trinity Church and will have a \$3.00 fee for each camper.

Mr. Whitford moved and Mr. Shoaf <sup>seconded</sup> the motion that Mrs. J. O. Cox be given the opportunity to go <sup>to</sup> Camp Junaluska for the leadership training school.
