Professor R.N. Wilson opened the Commission of Education meeting on November 29 with prayer. Nominations were made for officers. Mr. W.E. Whitford was elected chairman, Mr. Charles Chewning, vice-chairman, Mr. Phillip Umstead, secretary, Mrs. Ed Foreman, assistant secretary, and Mr. S.J. Angier, Treasurer.

Mrs. Seeley gave a report from the children's division. The commission discussed the nursery department. Mr. Whitford suggested the possibility of having another person in the church nursery.

Miss Cox gave a report about the record system. Haven written five churches as to their systems, she is compiling a card from three of these and from the Presbyterian system. It was moved that a meeting be held of department ^{r class} secretaries to view and discuss the various cards. It was reported that six Christmas trees would be brought to the church by December 12. It was also reported that the nursery department would have an open house on December 13.

Mr. Whitford read a note of thanks from Miss Elizabeth Johnson for the watch which she received.

Mr. Fisher invited the commission to the district set-up meeting on December 1 at Trinity Church.

Copies of Church School were available to all members of the Commission, Mr. Whitford stated.

It was decided that the regular meeting time would be the third Monday night of each month at 7:30 p.m.

The meeting was then adjourned.
