

On June 17, 1957 the Commission on Education met with the following members present. Mr. Whitford, Mr. Queen, Mr. Umstead, Mr. Angier, Dr. Holton, Mrs. Bookout, Mrs. Aydlett, Miss Glass, Mrs. Coble.

Mrs. Bookout reported that Mrs. Sam Holton will head the home visitation committee with Mrs. John P. Peran and Mrs. E. M. Robertson serving on the committee. Mrs. Lois V. Smith is on the staff of 3 year old nursery dept.

Dr. Sam Holton moved, Mrs. Bookout seconded, that the Commission suggest to Mr. Shoaf that he attend the Leadership Training School at Lake Junaluska in August.

Mrs. H. Brinkley will serve as superintendent of Junior Intermediate^{Dept} until October at which time Miss Laurel Glass will take over.
