ENROLLMENT

- 109 children came
96 attended 3 or more days and were therefore officially enrolled.
- Staff - 37 teachers and assistants
14 helpers provided nursery care for children of staff members.

OFFERING

\$ 33.37 will be used to send "Stories of Jesus" pamphlets to children in other lands.

EVALUATION

Interest of boys and girls was unusually good as shown

- (1) by fact that same number attended on last as on the first day,
- (2) parents spoke many words of appreciation and approval when they attended the final session,
- (3) response of children to the program was considered very good by staff of each department.

Units of Study were highly approved by staff members. The staff felt a real sense of accomplishment and personal satisfaction. Initial enrollment was about the same as for the past five years, but far below what a church of 1800 members should have. It is felt that the Commission should study the problem of reaching such a low percentage of Sunday School Class enrollment participating in the Vacation Church School.

PROBLEMS

- (1) Personal work by regular Church School staff to interest children and inform parents of Vacation Church School before session opens.
- (2) Problem of transportation be attacked, possibly through cooperation with adult classes.

TRAINING OF WORKERS

Training of Workers was done by one meeting for all and three departmental meetings. This seemed adequate for those workers who availed themselves of both opportunities. All should ideally have done so.
