

October 30, 1934.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Holton, and prayer was offered by Mr. Porter. The minutes were read and approved.

The general superintendent announced that the following divisional superintendents had been secured: Children's Division, Mr. Irving Allen; and, Adult Division, Mr. Alton Knight, both of whom were present at this meeting. A superintendent for the Young People's Division had not been secured at that time.

A committee composed of Prof. Wilson, Reba Cousins, and Gerald Cooper was appointed to see to it that a meeting of the whole Young People's Division was called to elect their special representative to the Board of Christian Education.

Prof. Wilson reported on the Scout work. He said that the membership was increasing and that more of the boys were from this church.

Mr. Knight made the report for the Adult Division and asked for some suggestions on the work. A suggestion was made for keeping up with the attendance, of dividing the division into small groups with various people responsible for looking after the groups. Also, a suggestion was made for organizing the Adult Council in order that the work of the different classes might be better correlated and plans for the whole Division made.

Mr. Allen reported that the Children's Division now had a full staff of teachers, including some added since the last election and to be elected at this meeting. The following teachers were elected: Nursery Department -- Mrs. Rainey Hawkins

Primary Department -- Helen Card

Junior Department -- Miss Virginia Parker

McMurzay Richie

Mr. C.B. Pifer, Miss Ada Eure, Charles Edwards, assistants.







A suggestion was brought in from the last Workers' Council for a Workers' Library for the help and assistance of the teachers and workers in the various departments of our Church School. The Board approved the suggestion and appointed the secretary of the Board as librarian. Books are to be collected from members of the school who have any that might be of use and which they would like to contribute. It was also suggested that an attempt be made to keep a file of periodical literature for future reference.

The pastor asked the Board for suggestions as to the elective members of this Board for next year, and a number of suggestions were made from which he could make his nominations.

The installation of the officers and teachers of the Church School was set for Sunday morning, November 18, following the fourth quarterly conference at which time the elections for next year would be completed.

Mr. Porter then brought up the matter of our participation in the Sunday School Athletic League sponsored by the Y.M.C.A. The Board decided that there was no real need for it in our school, that plenty of provision was made for such outside of the church, and that it would not press the matter at this time. If a definite demand for such participation should arise in the school and someone were available to look after it, there might be a re-consideration later.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
